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# Hydrogen Breath Test Instructions

The hydrogen breath test is designed to determine if you are unable to digest lactose and fructose. The test also can determine if there is a bacterial overgrowth in the small intestine.

### 2 Weeks prior to test:

NO colonoscopy, barium, or antibiotics

#### Medications to avoid 7 days prior to test:

 Zegerid(Omeprazole/sodium bicarbonate), Prilosec (Omeprazole), Prevacid (Lansoprazole), Aciphex (Rabeprazole), Protonix (Pantoprazole), Nexium (Esomeprazole), Dexilant

#### Medications to avoid 5 days prior to test:

Anti-diarrheals, fiber medications, miralax, and other laxatives.

#### Day before the test:

- If diet not strictly followed, test will need to be rescheduled.
- Only Foods Allowed: Baked or broiled chicken, fish or turkey (salt & pepper only), plain white rice, eggs, chicken/beef broth, plain white bread.
- Only Liquids Allowed: Water, coffee, tea. (No additives).
- Do NOT eat or drink 12 hrs. prior to the test. Only PLAIN water may be consumed.
- Do NOT sleep, exercise, or smoke for 1 hour before the test.

#### What to expect the day of the test:

- You can use inhalers up to 1 hour prior to test.
- Hold morning medications until after the test.
- You will be asked to give a breath sample into a bag at the start of the test and every 20-60 minutes after.
- You will ingest specific sugar water for the test after the baseline breath sample.
- You will be here for 3 hours from the start of the test.
- You may want to bring reading materials (WiFi available).
- You will wait in the waiting area between breath samples.
- Do NOT eat, smoke, sleep, or exercise during the test.

## When you are finished with the test:

- Schedule the next hydrogen breath test before you leave, if needed.
- The results of the test will be called to you in 1 week.
- You may possibly be visiting with nurse practitioner same day of breath test.
- Schedule of follow up with ordering physician before you leave.
