Rectal Endoscopic Ultrasound (EUS) Instructions

The day before the exam:

- You may have a light meal around 3:00 p.m. (i.e. half sandwich, soup).
- At 5:00 p.m. drink 1 bottle of Suprep.

This may be purchased at the pharmacy of your choice (no red coloring).

- Drink only clear fluids from this point until after the exam.

Things you may have are:

Apple juice ~ White grape juice ~ Jello ~ Popsicles ~ Gatorade ~ Water ~ Soft drinks ~ Kool-Aid
Hi-C ~ Clear broth ~ Boullion ~ (No purple or red items)

The day of the exam:

- Do not eat breakfast.
- Do not take diabetic medication until after the exam. You may check your blood sugar prior to arrival.
- You can drink clear liquids until 2 hours prior to your procedure _____.
- When you arrive at the facility, you will be given an enema in preparation for the exam.
- You must have a driver due to the the sedation you will receive. You will not be able to drive or work until the next day.
